Parking:

Clothing:

Girls

are asked to dress in a white dress, below the knee in length, shoulders should be covered. We also suggest white low-heeled dress shoes. Headpieces/veils and gloves may also be worn. Please remove the gloves before receiving Communion.

Boys

are asked to wear a white suit, white shirt and white tie with white shoes OR a navy blue blazer, khaki pants, white shirt and white tie with dress shoes.

Pictures and Videos

Due to the solemnity of the Mass, we ask that no one take pictures/videos or move around the Church in order to take pictures/videos during the ceremony. Please be sure to share this information with all your guests.

Photography:

A professional photographer from O'Connor Studios will be available for photos of this special day. They will provide individual pictures of your child before Mass and a picture of your child receiving First Communion.

<u>Individual First Holy Communion Pictures before Mass:</u>

Your child should arrive an hour before Mass if you intend to have your child's picture taken. Pictures are taken on a first come, first served basis.

Individual First Holy Communion Picture of Receiving:

Individual pictures of your child receiving his/her First Holy Communion will also be taken.

First Holy Communion Mass Recorded:

The entire Mass will be video recorded and posted to our website for you or your family to view.

May Procession:

On Sunday, May 2nd and Sunday, May 9th at the 9:00 a.m. Family Mass, all First Communicants will participate in the May Procession in their First Holy Communion attire.

The students will meet at 8:45 a.m. in Father Gillis Hall and will process in and out as a group. The children will sit together at the Mass adhering to social distancing protocols. Please meet your child in the hall after Mass.



How to receive Holy Communion

Please try to practice this with your child at home. Thank you for all your support as we prepare for this special and holy occasion.

- Approach the altar with prayer hands in front of you.
- When you have reached the priest (Fr. Ron), bow before Jesus.
- Place DOMINANT hand under other hand to prepare to receive Jesus. In other words "Make a plate!"
- The priest (Fr. Ron) will say "The Body of Christ" and place the Host in your hand.
- Say **AMEN**. Step aside, pick up the Host with your DOMINANT hand and place the Host in your mouth.
- Walk back to the pew with hands together, kneel and pray thanking God for this awesome gift and for all your blessings.
- Remain kneeling until the Tabernacle is closed.
