Know the 10 Commandments (in order):

1. I am the LORD your God. You shall worship the Lord your God and Him only shall you serve.
2. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
3. Remember to keep holy the Sabbath day.
4. Honor your father and your mother.
5. You shall not kill.
6. You shall not commit adultery.
7. You shall not steal.
8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

Know the 7 Sacraments (with explanation):

1. Baptism – The Sacrament of Baptism washes away Original Sin and welcomes us into God's family
2. Reconciliation – Absolves us of sin
3. Eucharist – We receive Jesus in the True Presence
4. Confirmation – We become a soldier for Christ by confirming our faith and receive an outpouring of the Holy Spirit.
5. Matrimony – A man and a woman become one in marriage
6. Holy Order – A man becomes a priest
7. Anointing of the Sick – The anointing given to a person by a priest for a healing and/or to be absolved of all sins

- The Hail Mary
- The Glory Be
- Sign of the Cross
