Lent

Lent is the 40 day Liturgical Season of fasting, special prayers and almsgiving in preparation for Easter.

Your final exam will include an essay on your Lenten journey.

Know the 10 Commandments (in order):

- 1. I am the LORD thy God. Thou shalt not have strange gods before me.
- 2. Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain.
- 3. Remember to keep holy the Sabbath.
- 4. Honor thy father and thy mother.
- 5. Thou shalt not kill.
- 6. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- 7. Thou shalt not steal.
- 8. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
- 9. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife.
- 10. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's goods.

Know the 7 Sacraments (with explanation):

- 1. Baptism The Sacrament of Baptism washes away Original Sin and welcomes us into God's family
- 2. Reconciliation Absolves us of sin
- 3. Eucharist We receive Jesus in the True Presence
- 4. Confirmation We become a soldier for Christ by confirming our faith and receive an outpouring of the Holy Spirit.
- 5. Matrimony A man and a women become one in marriage
- 6. Holy Order A man becomes a priest
- 7. Anointing of the Sick The anointing given to a person by a priest for a healing and/or to be absolved of all sins
