Is your child achieving success?

This past April, I challenged our ninth grade students to create goals for themselves as they continue growing in their faith and inching closer and closer to the date of their Confirmation. We discussed their plans for reading the Bible, attending Mass regularly, actively participating in Corporal Works of Mercy, adding prayer time to their day, and holding each other accountable in achieving

their goals with continued Catholic community. Each student left class with their own unique plan written down.

With four months past, this is a great time to check in with your child to see how they are progressing with their goals. Are they achieving what they set out to accomplish? Are they having some difficulties? Ask how you as a parent can help them. Would a weekly family Bible study

help motivate your child to begin reading small chunks of the Bible narrative? Would adding prayer before meals, before school, or before bed be a way to bring your child closer in his or her relationship with God? Would attending Youth Group help establish a Catholic community of peers? Communication is key in being able to have a continual open dialogue with your child about his or her faith journey.
